## Other Required Program Components

### STUDY GROUPS

The class is divided into six Study Groups. Each group will set its own meeting dates during the Fall Retreat. Meetings are opportunities to discuss the program topics in-depth, in an intimate setting. They will be once a month, in the evenings, in group members' homes.

### LEADERSHIP PROJECTS
